Natalie Dickerson – Bronze – T-shirt Design, Ben Hart – Gold – Internetworking, Ashton Hetherington – Gold – Welding, Josh Keller – Silver – Information Technology Services, Spencer Midkiff – Silver – Automotive Service Technology, Aiden Morgan – Gold – Precision Machine Technology, Zach Ratcliff – Silver – Architectural Drafting, Colton Snidow – Silver – Technical Drafting and Hannah Steele – Silver – Cosmetology. Ben Hart and Ashton Hetherington will have the opportunity to compete at the National Level in June if they choose to.

Dr. Arbogast stated that he gave board members a draft LEA plan for safe return to in person instruction.
