The board vice-chairman called the work session to order.

The School Board, on motion of Mr. Pennington, with second by Mrs. Guynn and unanimous voting, approved to have Mr. Wilburn and Mr. Steele participate electronically if they are able.

Individuals from CMTA attended to present the opportunity assessment after going through the schools and reviewing utility information. Discussions included lighting, HVAC systems, roofs, solar opportunities, etc. After going through the assessment, they presented 3 proposed project summaries and discussed pricing and immediate needs.
