Dr. Arbogast shared that the training that the Sheriff's Office planned to do at Giles High School/Giles Tech Center has been moved to another day. Board members wanted to make sure that notification will be sent out prior to the training so that the community knows.

Dr. Arbogast stated that there will be a meeting on July 28<sup>th</sup> with Randy from ZMM to discuss Macy facilities issues. Two board members will attend, along with John Ross and Dr. Brown.

Dr. Arbogast discussed water softeners at the schools. He stated that they have received quotes from 3 different companies. He stated that Southern Air had the lower quotes. He will let Dr. Brown know to get this process started. Mr. Buckland asked about the cost of the chemicals. Dr. Arbogast wasn't sure about this.

Dr. Arbogast stated that there is some work that the schools want to do on the football fields. There is some field mix that they want to put on the fields. There was discussion on how to bring the mix in. The consensus of the board is to have the company from New Castle deliver the mix and they will pay the delivery fee.

There was discussion on the Stride agreement. Mr. Buckland wants to make sure that the county attorney reviews this agreement as well.
